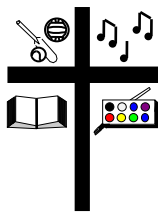

Reports

This summer you will receive a general report about your child (covering the period up to the end of March) from us electronically, after 9th July. In recognition of the impact of coronavirus, the government have removed the requirement to report attendance data for pupils or report upon any curriculum assessments.

Class Organisation September 2020

We are awaiting the government guidance for infection control for schools for September so that we may put the necessary plans into place. All measures we have now, or put in to place, are to keep us all safe so we can stay open as much as possible. Going forward we hope for guidance on staggered arrival/collection times and class 'bubbles', after school club provision, snacks, lunch times, no exchanging of items, etc... We will advise you as soon as we can on what school may 'look' like.

When school reopens in September we are planning on asking children to wear school uniform. We are requesting that **this must be clean each day**, so you can supplement this with appropriate non-uniform items as the week goes on. At the moment, ties are not required, as often children only have one. Please name all items of clothing. This will be subject to review.

All being well, Year 1 to 6 pupils return to school on Wednesday 2nd September 2020. Reception pupils will be starting at a later date.
